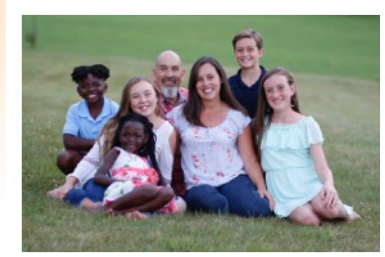
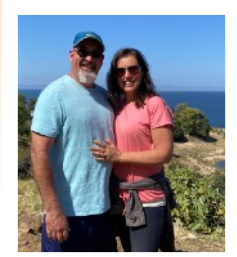




# Renewal Ministries

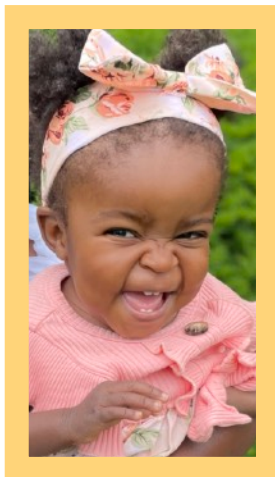

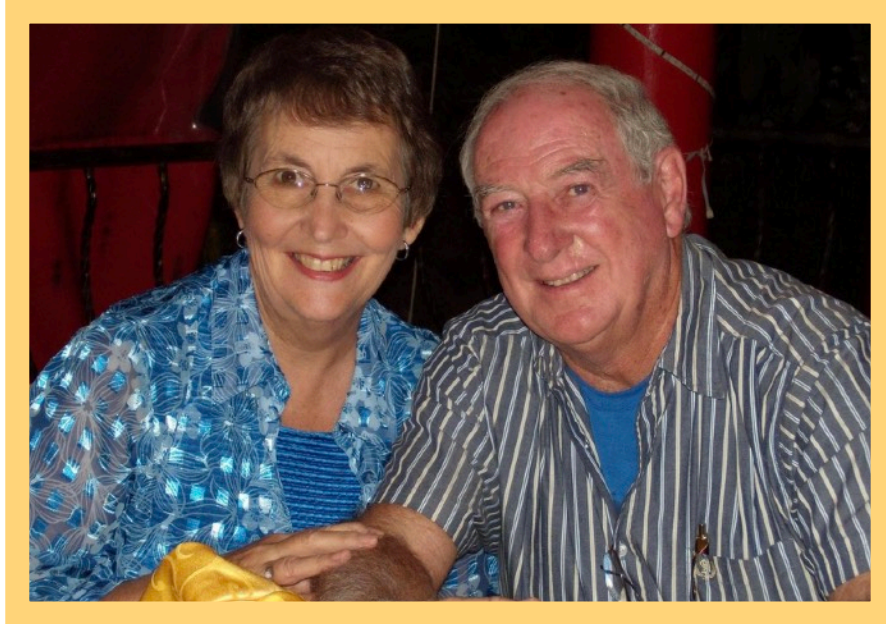

## **Fulfillment of a Vision**

In the early 2000's when the shopping center was bought as the site for Renewal Fellowship, part of the original vision Dave & Maxine had was to put in a fuel station that would fund ministry and community projects. As often happens in our walk with God, His timing and ours do not always align. This part of the vision didn't materialize.

In 2015 David was approached by somebody to put a fuel station on the property under what is called a BOT agreement (Build-Operate-Transfer). Under this arrangement, the company would front all the investment capital for an agreed upon fuel station. The company would then be allowed to operate the fuel station for 5 years rent free. At the termination of this period, all assets would be handed over to the church, and the company would be given a renewable lease from which all proceeds would go towards ministry and community development projects. This proposal was presented to the Renewal Fellowship board and congregation, and everyone agreed that God was in this idea and we proceeded.

Unfortunately, after going through the necessary approvals for the development, the company ran into financial struggles and could no longer follow through. Due to the fact that the church is debt free, part of the arrangement had been no liens or loans against the property would be able to be used to secure the financing so as not to jeopardize God's property. They offered to connect us with another fuel company who would have loved to take advantage of our site with a similar deal. After praying about

this offer, our team had the strong sense that this felt much like Sarah offering for Abraham to have Hagar as a means of fulfilling God's promise. We declined the offer, feeling this was the right partner and that if not with them, we should not move forward.

Seven years later, at the beginning of the Hebrew year 5772, David was ministering on the significance of the season and prophesied that many things that had been on the back burner would come to fruition that year. Three weeks later, after not hearing from John for seven years, he called David out of the blue and shared that he once again had the capital necessary to move forward with the fuel station.



By the grace of God, through that next year, we reinstated all the permits and in 2023 construction began. The fuel station opened in January of this year. Although they never got to see it, we rejoice in the fulfillment of God's promise and Dave & Maxine's vision. It's not uncommon for people, who started with Dave & Maxine, to see the fuel station and comment that they remember them talking about this huge vision.

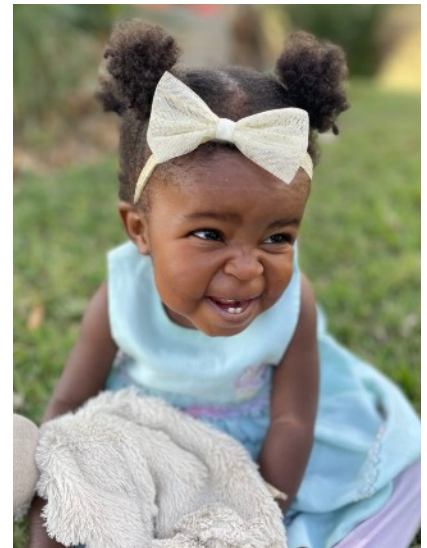
