### Dear Family, Friends & Partners,

Greetings to you all! These past couple of months have been busy ones as we've had a front row seat to see some of the wonderful things God has been doing in Zimbabwe. Over the course of the past 10 weeks, our family has helped facilitate and / or coordinated four different Christian camps, David has gone on two separate ministry trips in Zimbabwe, and we hosted the national homeschool conference, along with all the routine runnings of the church, homeschool club and preparing for our family to travel to the US for our annual trip.

## **Goat Project**

These past couple months have been busy ones for David as he made several ministry trips to different parts of the country. First he went to the southern goat project in the rural area of Chivi, about 5 hours south Harare. He spoke at their semi-annual pastors conference, which was attended by about 70 pastors. The orphans that have been part of and benefitted from the goat project gave a special presentation to say thank you for how life changing it has been for them.











## **National Ministry**

Then two weeks later David took a 6 hour drive down to the border town of Beitbridge to do a 3 day leadership seminar with the leadership of Ambassadors

Christian Fellowship. About 70 leaders and pastors from around Zimbabwe were in attendance. The time culminated with Darlington coming down to join David to preach the Sunday morning service to a crowd of nearly 1000 people. They shared the message of Forgiveness and Reconciliation which was well received and there was much ministry time that followed.







## **Family Camp**

At the beginning of May we hosted our third family camp out at Lasting Impressions camp about two hours south of Harare. We had nine families join us to learn about developing a culture of blessing in our homes as we raise our children. Over the course of 4 days, we taught on the Biblical roles of parents, the damage that the lack of those roles being fulfilled in our lives can cause, and how to receive healing for past wounds. Anaya taught two sessions to all the kids that were present on how to develop healthy sibling relationships. We ended the last night of camp with a formal dinner and blessing ceremony where each of the fathers took turns pronouncing a coming of age blessing over their tween and teenage children as they pass from childhood into their youth years. It was a beautiful and powerful ceremony as the climax of the special week.



#### **National Outreach**

This past month Renewal Fellowship was one of the hosts for the national Read Through the Bible Event. David spoke at one of the other local churches at the opening service to launch the reading starting in Genesis, and many members of Renewal Fellowship took turns reading in 15 minute increments through our portion of scripture.













David has become a regular guest preacher at a local church service that serves the folks of a retirement community in Harare. He enjoys getting to share with them on a regular basis which he is able to do because of our strong teaching team covering Sundays back at Renewal Fellowship.

Speaking of our strong teaching team, Amy has been challenged by the Lord to do a lot more ministry this year, speaking at 3 different events this past month. As part of our service to the Homeschool Community in Zimbabwe we hosted the 3rd annual Homeschool conference and Amy was the closing speaker. So many were blessed by her challenge to "Homeschool from Wholeness."
